S-10 Blazer is the sport utility vehicle that can come on tough scrambling through the countryside. Yet, it's also practical as an in-town family wagon. The choices are all yours.

**4X4 OR 2-WHEEL DRIVE.** S-10 Blazer offers a 2-wheel-drive model for drivers who never plan on blazing new trails (see page 6). And a 4-wheel-drive model with the patented Insta-Trac 4x4 system for those who do.

**OTHER BIG CHOICES.** Gas V6 or I4 power. Gas engines include the standard 2.0 Liter 4-cylinder (1.9 Liter in California) with 4-speed over-drive manual transmission, and the available 2.8 Liter V6. See Engine Chart on page 14 for more details.

Choose a 2,000-, 4,000- or 5,000-lb. towing capacity. Properly equipped 2WD S-10 Blazers can tow up to 5,000 lbs. —S-10 4x4s, up to 4,000 lbs. —including trailer and cargo. Compare that with a maximum of 2,000 lbs. for any import pickup. And every S-10 Blazer has a standard payload capacity of 1,000 lbs. that's not affected by adding options.

Choose from a wide selection of options, too. Big, fat on/off-road tires. A tachometer. Power windows. Power door locks. And much, much more. See pages 12, 13 and 14 for a complete listing of S-10 Blazer options.

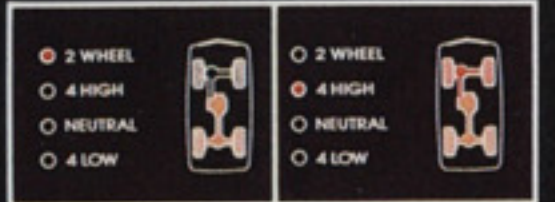
## INSTA-TRAC.

### A 4X4 SYSTEM SO ADVANCED, NO OTHER OFF-ROAD SYSTEM CAN BEAT IT.

The patented Insta-Trac, standard in every S-10 Blazer 4x4, is state-of-the-art for the industry. It lets you shift from freewheeling 2-wheel drive to ground-grabbing 4-wheel-drive High—and back—at any speed.

To do it, you simply move a single lever inside the cab. No slowing down, no stopping. Insta-Trac also provides a lighted action display on the shift console. It clearly indicates when you're in the 2- or 4-wheel-drive mode.

You only stop the S-10 Blazer when shifting into or out of low-range 4-wheel drive. And even then, you just make your shift and resume driving. You don't have to reverse the vehicle, leave the vehicle, or move any other lever.



### OPTIONAL NEW OFF-ROAD PACKAGE FEATURES GAS-PRESSURE SHOCK ABSORBERS.

Delco Bilstein gas-pressure shocks are the heart of Chevy S-10 4x4's available off-road package. Pressure from a gas cell helps tires maintain road contact. Mixing of shock oil with air is totally eliminated for impressive control of suspension movements even on the highway. (Available, Oct., 1983.)

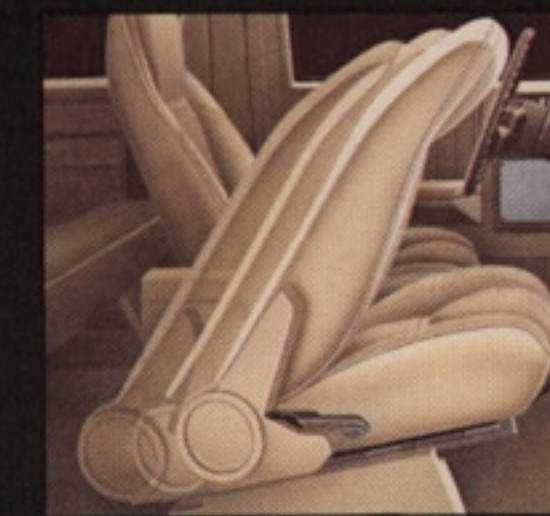
### STANDARD.

A QUICK LOOK AT WHAT YOU WANT IN A SPORT UTILITY VEHICLE.

1. Available 5-speed manual transmission with overdrive for a performance punch, especially with available V6.
2. Wire-wrapped brake lines are Zincroterne® coated to help resist corrosion.
3. Precise metal-to-metal fit and automatic welding techniques help maintain a high standard of quality.
4. A tough, brilliant paint finish is up to five layers deep. It's a brilliant, four-layer paint finish with an extra fifth layer: a chip-resistant coating on the lower body side panels.
5. Hot-wax coating on the entire steel frame helps fight the effects of road salt and dirt.
6. Double-wall construction is used in the windshield pillars, cowl, hood, front fenders, tailgate and rear side panels.
7. 4x4 independent front suspension lets front wheels work independently for impressive traction. Includes stabilizer and torsion bars computer-matched to the specific truck you order.
8. A ride that's neither too hard nor too soft. Shock valving on 4x4 models is a good compromise between on- and off-road travel.
9. Extensive anti-corrosion treatments. Special steels, primers, sealers and weather stripping help keep the elements out and the quality in.
10. 15-inch wheels with P195/75R-15 radial ply tires are standard on S-10 Blazer.
11. 7.1-inch front-axle and 8.2-inch rear-axle ground clearance is provided with available P235/75R-15 on/off-road, steel-belted, radial ply tires on 4x4 models.
12. Low step-in height for easy entry and exit.
13. Variable-ratio steering gear for quick response.
14. Grab handles for front and rear passengers in 4x4 models.
15. 4x4 front-axle locking sleeve for shifting from 2 Wheel to 4 High and back at any speed.
16. Available 2.8 Liter V6. No small import truck offers you V6 power.

A WORD ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE CHEVROLET PRODUCTS.

The Chevy Blazers described in this catalog (Series S-10: 2WD and 4WD) are assembled at facilities of GM Truck & Bus Group. These Chevs incorporate thousands of different components produced by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Chevrolet products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Chevrolet products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Chevrolet name.

With respect to factory-installed extra-cost optional equipment, make certain you specify the type of equipment you desire on your vehicle when ordering it from your dealer. Some options may be unavailable when your vehicle is built. Your dealer receives advice regarding current availability of options. You may ask your dealer for this information. GM also requests the dealer to advise you if an option you ordered is unavailable. We suggest that you verify that your vehicle includes the optional equipment you ordered or, if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.
